

## **Tests for Module 1**

### **“Basics of prevention of alcoholism and drug addiction”**

A 44-year-old man, before seeking help from a psychiatrist, consumed 0.5-0.8 liters of vodka daily for 6 days. On the 3rd day, he could not sleep at night, became anxious, complained that he saw a “horror movie shown on the wall”, heard screams from the street, threatening to kill him, believed that he was “at the factory”. What is the most likely diagnosis?

A 35-year-old man was operated on for acute appendicitis three days ago. The postoperative period was without complications, there is some irritability, restless sleep.
